

On the occasion of the Annual Meeting of the Danish Electrochemical Society, the society is organising a two days conference on "Electrochemical Science and Technology". Primary aim of the conference is to foster an interdisciplinary interaction between students working in the broad area of 'Electrochemical Science and Technology'. Today, the application of electrochemistry is wide and effectively used in almost all disciplines, and the future growth demands cross boundary interaction between Scientists, Engineers, and Technologists of various disciplines engaged in electrochemical research and development.

The proposed conference will focus on bringing together electrochemistry work force in Denmark and on informing industry about main research subjects in the field. The conference will mainly focus on contributions from Ph.D. and Post-Docs as Oral or Poster presentation. There will be invited contributions from Academic and Industrial experts. Society welcomes all students to use the conference as a platform for evaluating their research on a wider perspective, and a training ground for scientific presentations and discussions.

There will be a social gathering as part of the conference on the first day evening to bring together participants in an informal atmosphere.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

Authors are requested to submit abstracts before August 15th 2006. The abstracts should contain the title of the paper, authors and their affiliation, postal and email addresses, keywords, subject and main references. The abstract should be written in English and contain maximum 500 words.

Proposed papers for oral or poster presentation will be selected by the organising committee. However, authors are requested to make their choice on the type of presentation during abstract submission.

The contributions from students need not to be a completed research programme. Also reports about ongoing research are welcome and research plans of students at the beginning of their projects as well for poster presentation.

SCHEDULE OF THE CONFERENCE

The conference will last for two days. The event will start on the afternoon of 5th October with a lecture by an expert on "advances in electrochemical technique" followed by a conference reception. The reception will be at Esrum Kloster. The reception includes dinner, guided tour through the museum, and beer and wine tasting.

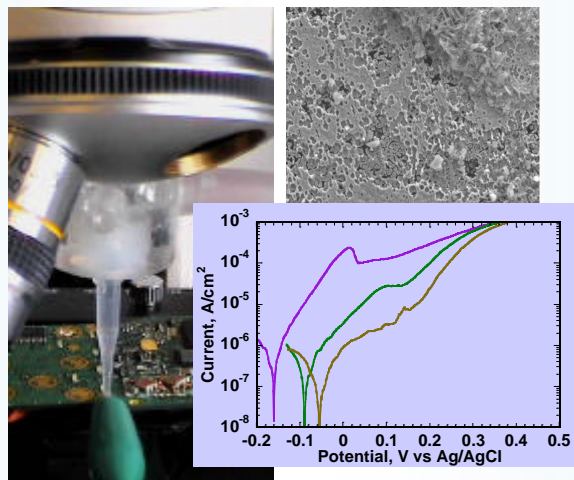

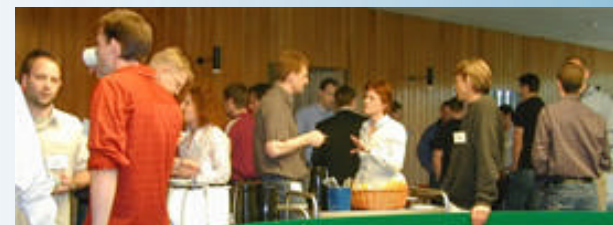
